

## 2 of DISKS - CHANGE

**Key Words:** *Jupiter in Capricorn; change, transformation.*

A huge snake, symbol for infinity. This signifies perpetual change. The snake encloses two disks, the Chinese yin/yang, symbols of balance and harmony. They turn in opposite directions, representing internal and external change. The triangles, which are ancient alchemical symbols, are painted in the colors of the four elements; red for fire, blue for water, grey for earth and yellow for air. The transformation touches all realms of being.

Jupiter, the planet symbolizing luck and expansion, indicates that the change will bring luck and enrich life. The new will bring more stability and security (Capricorn) with it.

Change is always necessary when the old falls out of equilibrium. Changes shake us and wake us up. The crown on the snake's head is a symbol of wakefulness.

The violet color (color of the warrior) shows that new energies will be drawn from the transformation. The only permanent thing is impermanence. The only certain thing is uncertainty.

**Indication:** Your life is subject to a constant change which allows you to grow, extending and expanding you, ultimately enriching you. Give yourself up to the transformation with trust!

**Questions:** What internal or external changes are going on in your life? Where are you still clinging?

**Suggestion:** Meditate on the statement: The only constant thing is change.

**Affirmation:** Every day, in every way, I am getting better and better.

**The Two of Disks** represents change. The oriental Uroboros snake that eats its own tail reminds us that change is the only constant and is cyclic. For purposes of rebalancing that which is out of balance, the serpent is making the number 8, which is the number for balance and adjustment. Change is for the purpose of expanding our awareness, which is symbolized by the crown on the snake's head. Change is also for the purpose of revealing to us that which is knowable, and that which is unfamiliar, which is represented by the black and white serpent. The black and white serpent is the oriental representation of the yin-yang symbol, which is associated with the principle of unifying opposites. The Two of Disks represents tangible changes that can be pointed to in the external reality which is reflected by the yin yang symbols that are horizontally on their sides. The vertical yin! yang symbol indicates internal change, Change Whereas the horizontal yin yang symbol indicates external change. The change that is represented here is also elemental, because within the yin-yang symbols, the old alchemical symbols of the elements of earth, fire, water and air are drawn in their triangular shapes. The astrological aspect of this card is Jupiter in Capricorn. This is expansive, positive, opportunistic change (Jupiter) that is also stable, solid and secure, which is Capricorn.

When you pull this card, it indicates that in the next two weeks or the next two months, there is an opportunity to make external changes that are both expansive and stable in your life. It is an opportunity to make changes that can rebalance your life experience. The Two of Disks indicates that in the next two weeks or the next two months is a good time to make expansive and more balancing changes in your relationships with Capricorn people, anyone born December 21 to January 21.
